

Durham University Canoe Club Rules 2013



C1 and C2 river racers should not be used unless you have asked permission from either Abbie Cresswell or Mark Stillings before use. If you do not ask for permission there will be a £20 fine.

All debts on club accounts must be paid off before you graduate, the university will be made aware of any money still on your account and will stop you graduating until it is paid.

No seal launching from the concrete steps as this damages the boats- please ask for help instead.

On weekends away paddlers are now required to sign out equipment with the designated leader of the trip. Should you misplace kit on the trip then you will be charged for its replacement.

Ensure you have filled out a health and safety form before you get on the water, spare forms are in the boathouse- please speak to a member of the exec.

Club equipment should be put away tidily after use and boats drained if necessary.

Lost, broken or damaged kit should be reported to the kit officer of your campus.

Under no circumstances should club trips go ahead until the designated river leader has sent a trip form to Team Durham. Should a trip form have not been sent to TD and club kit used then there will be a £20 fine.

Boathouse keys are available for drivers, kayakers who train regularly and coaches at Maiden Castle reception. Should you use this key please return it as soon as your session has finished.
