

## DUCC Exec Minutes 29/09/24

Present: Ben, Erica, Sophie, Noah, Will, Charlotte, Izzy, Charlie (minutes).

*\*Noah discusses kayaking in a ditch during the summer.*

Ben: need 4 leaders per fresher session – put sessions on website for sign up.

Erica: Should we market them as intro or fresher sessions? General agreement on latter.

*\*Admiral Fife joins from a ship somewhere in Scotland.*

Ben: we have enough people to lead fresher sessions. Has received details for exec training on Thursday.

Will: started planning pizza social – probably 6pm on Friday 4<sup>th</sup>?

Erica/Charlotte: Better on Sunday as more returners and freshers more likely to come along. General agreement.

Ben: freshers fair – lots of volunteers to help. Carry someone around in a kayak again. Erg, whiteboard etc.

Will: Leaflets – use old ones too.

Charlotte: if tigers drive they could get a cheaper pool session.

Noah: maybe first few pool sessions just DUCC so it's less intimidating for freshers.

Ben: also don't forget rolling.

Charlotte: possible to do both as Darlington pool is big.

Ben: should we limit number son pool sessions?

Charlotte: ask Mark what he thinks. Who is going to teach rolling? Ask in FSRT chat.

Noah: keen to do a rescue refresher session on Tuesday. Others to join.

Charlotte: maybe a grade 2/3 trip to practice rescues. Tyne tour – we should go. Close to WWR.

Izzy: women's polo planning to train really hard this year.

Charlie: send me stash emails so I can sort out the outstanding fleeces.

Charlotte: should we raise membership by £5?

Will: not keen, would need proper justification especially after TD membership fee. Could just get two more members. General agreement.
